We have significantly improved our practice with the introduction of two very experienced dentists - Dr Cathryn Whittenbury and Dr Roxane Francisco.

Recently we have introduced a Cone Beam Volumetric Tomography (CBVT) x-ray machine into our practice. This technology takes 3D images similar to a CT Scan but with less radiation. We are currently using these

images for planning implant positions, as well as for endodontics (root canal treatment), for wisdom teeth extraction, and for many other examinations where a plain radiograph does not show us everything we need to see.

We love all of the positive feedback about our new building. It certainly has allowed us the room to continue providing best practice dentistry and the natural light provides a great environment for the high aesthetic cases where colour matching teeth is critical.

Adam Lake has now set up his practice upstairs providing physiotherapy services for a wide range of conditions. He has been very popular and has worked together with us in relieving facial pain for those who suffer from bruxism.

The importance of regular dental visits




There is no question that we all want to avoid toothaches, tooth decay and gum disease. Ultimately, we all want the same thing: our teeth for life. The best way to maintain excellent oral health is by brushing and flossing daily using a high-quality toothbrush, toothpaste and floss, as well as regular dental check-ups and cleaning by a dental health professional. At Advanced Dental Centre, we focus on keeping your teeth and gums healthy. We are a proactive dental practice with a strong belief in preventative dental care. As a minimum we recommend six-monthly hygiene visits and will encourage you to book appointments in advance.

Our preventive dentistry service includes:

- Tooth cleaning: removing the build up of plaque and calculus from the teeth and restoring soft tissue health.
- Comprehensive dental examination: includes examination of teeth and soft tissues using visual, tactile and imaging techniques, and X-ray analysis.
- Education programs: advice on at-home care and nutrition.

Can *Botox* be used instead of an occlusal splint?

Bruxism is the habit of excessive clenching or grinding of the teeth. It is a behaviour which occurs most frequently at night but can also be experienced during the day. Long-term bruxism leads to excessive and permanent wear on teeth, places stress on the ligaments supporting the teeth and the temporomandibular joint (TMJ) which can lead to irreparable long-term damage. To prevent further damage, the use of an occlusal splint, more commonly known as a night guard can be worn while sleeping. But did you know that Botulinum toxin, also known as Botox can help prevent bruxism? Botox is used in an attempt to reduce the effects of over active Masseter muscles, the main muscle involved in bruxism. - EVALUATION OF THE JAW, SINUSES, NERVE CANALS AND NASAL CAVITY
- DETERMINING BONE STRUCTURE AND TOOTH ORIENTATION

Cone Beam technology offers us unique benefits with more clarity compared to traditional 2D x-rays of hard tissues. The 3D digital image provides us with an enhanced visualisation of your teeth, bones and surrounding hard and soft tissue with minimal radiation exposure.
