# SureSmile TRANSFORMATION

Perhaps you've heard about Invisalign for misaligned smiles. Whilst Invisalign was the first widely available system for clear aligners, competitors have now appeared on the market. SureSmile (like Invisalign) allows us to create a 3D model of your teeth. We then use advanced computer software to design your new smile. Your set-up is sent to a lab where your aligners are created and printed with a 3D printer. Each and every aligner is custom-made to fit your teeth and move them gradually into a straighter position. While we are sleeping our body goes into full recovery mode. It allows us to rest and recover for the next day ahead; this includes your oral health as well. It's common for people to experience dry mouth when they are sleeping, this mostly occurs in people over the age of 65 but like everything else, dry mouth doesn't discriminate.

Our saliva works to neutralise the acids in our mouth that can cause tooth decay, it also produces the first round of enzymes that we use to digest our food. All in all, our saliva does more than we think for our body so dry mouth doesn't just mean waking up uncomfortable, but it could lead to other health issues.

A common cause of a dry mouth is being a 'mouth breather'. While we sleep it is not uncommon for our mouth to drop open which allows us to breathe through our mouth instead of our nose. Mouth breathing can be a sign of nasal congestion or illness. If your nose is blocked your body automatically resorts to the only other breathing option, your mouth. Drinking more water will help to combat dry mouth, but many patients benefit from supplementing their normal oral routine with special mouthwashes and toothpastes that are now available.

If you think you might be suffering from dry mouth, speak to our Dentists or Oral Health Therapists and they'll help you with a management plan.

## when should I start brushing my child's teeth?

You should start cleaning your child's teeth as soon as the first tooth appears in the mouth - usually around 6-10 months of age. Cleaning and caring for your child's teeth early on sets up good dental care habits for life.

To develop strong teeth, your child needs a healthy, balanced diet made up of fresh foods such as vegetables, cheese and lean meats, minimal high-sugar foods such as biscuits and muesli bars, and drink fluoridated tap water.

To make sure your child's teeth and gums are kept healthy, it's a good idea for your child to see one of our Oral Health Therapists every six months. Our friendly team of Oral Health Therapists including Seja Majeed, Diem Tang, Maddie Glen & Zoe Stapley look forward to taking care of your child's dental needs.
