The benefits of the scheme covers a range of dental services including: x-rays, cleaning, fillings and root canal procedures. The benefit scheme does not cover any cosmetic services or orthodontic work.



#### THE FUTURE OF DENTISTRY

There are many options for replacing teeth but dental implants have provided us with a very natural looking and predictable treatment option that does not affect the remaining teeth. Dental implants are a state-of-the-art, versatile option for replacing single or multiple teeth and are widely accepted to be the most successful method of tooth replacement used today. Dental implants are titanium screws in the shape of the tooth root surgically placed which integrates with the jaw bone and serves as an artificial root on which a tooth crown can be attached. The resulting "tooth" will act, look and feel very similar to a natural tooth.

The practice of restoring teeth with implants involves both a surgical and restorative procedure, with a choice of intravenous sedation or local anaesthetic, you can rest easy during the procedure. Records including a 3-D xray are taken to determine the amount of bone present in the jaw, the space available for the implant, and how the bite comes together. Dr Scarpin then plans the surgery, according to those initial findings. Let's take a look at the process:



- 1. The implant is placed in the jawbone, this involves exposing the jaw bone and preparing the site, in a sterile environment, to receive the implant. You will need a subsequent visit after approximately 10 days, to have the sutures removed.
- 2. Once the implant is placed in the jawbone, it is left there for integration for a period of time. Your bone will now start growing around your new titanium dental implant, creating a sturdy base for your tooth. During this healing period, you may need a temporary tooth. If the implant is in a non aesthetic zone (not visible) then it can be left alone without a temporary tooth so the tissues can heal nicely.
- 3. A second surgery may take place, where we uncover the implant and place a healing abutment (a small metal stud on the top of the implant) and test the implant's connection to the jawbone. This confirms that the implant is a secure base for your new tooth.
- 4. Once the healing period is over, a permanent porcelain tooth can be put on top of the implant. A 3D scan of the implant is taken and a porcelain tooth is made. Once the tooth is made it will be fitted onto the implant and an x-ray is taken to ensure the fit is correct.
